 Plant List (5/1/2010)



This garden was installed in May 2010 as a demonstration of converting large expanses of concrete with various species appropriate for the Sunset District. It is accessible by the L-Taraval Muni Train. Located on city sidewalks, it is open for view, free of charge, all day, every day.

Plant*SF invites you to take this plant list along on your next visit. All species and materials used are commercially available through local nurseries. All are native or climate adapted (drought tolerant), meaning they are native to areas with similar climate conditions so require very little supplemental watering once established. This garden was hand-watered to establish and receives no ongoing irrigation. The plantings are arranged in three main groups: grasses, native and climate adapted perennials and succulents. Additional groupings appear near the curb and at the driveways. The garden features year-round blooming and plants that attract and support pollinators. Over 800 square feet of concrete was removed, increasing infiltration to the natural aquifer and diverting storm water away from the overloaded combined sewer system.
